WHERE: The Pike Road Arts Center's Water House Gallery, 944 Wallahatchie Rd (under the Water Tower)

WHEN: 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.

WHO: All ages are invited to visit the Arts Center, check out the new space, and celebrate Independence Day

through the arts. The Pike Road Arts Council looks forward to welcoming you to this new, local home for

the arts!

WHAT: Relax and enjoy the evening at the Town of Pike Road's SummerFest Celebration, featuring fireworks,

music by Brandon Self, and food from Southern Smoke Shack BBQ, Nancy's Italian Ice, and the

restaurants of The Waters Town Center. Admission is \$10 per vehicle.
